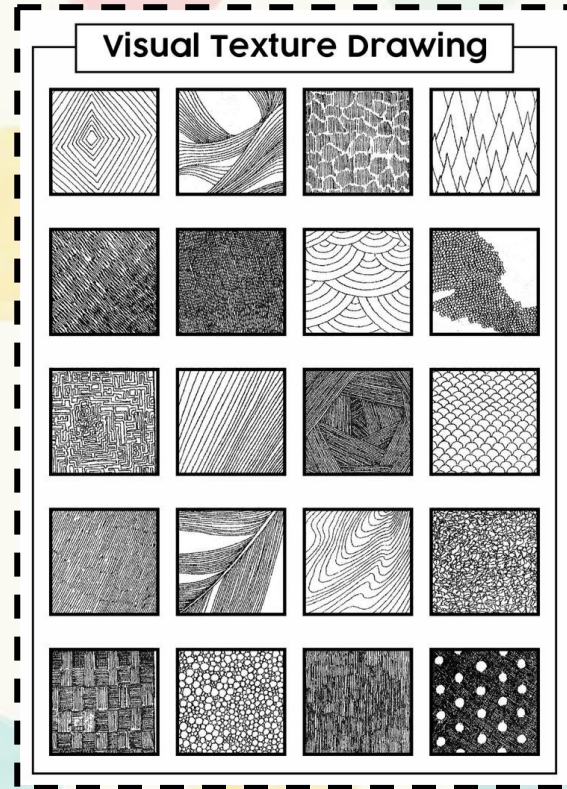
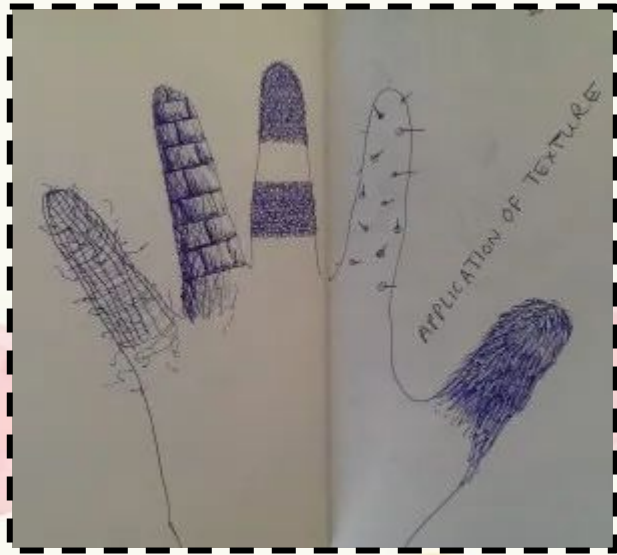

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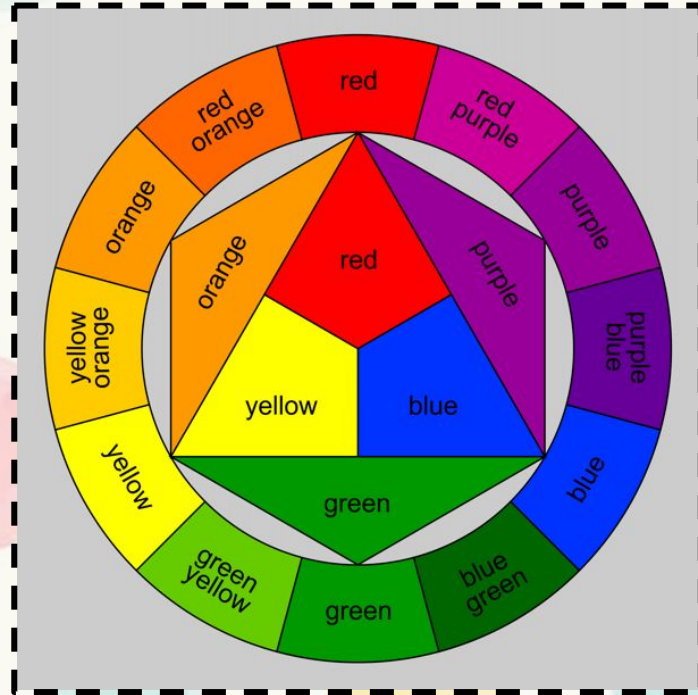
*Let's Learn Some Vocabulary!*

*Texture: how something feels, or how it looks like it would feel*





*Color: the pigment created by the way something looks*

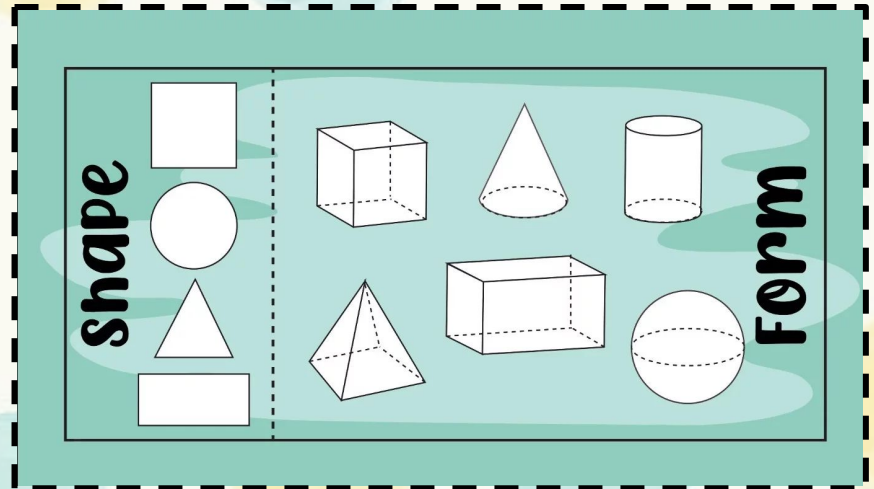


**3-D:** three dimensional piece, not flat

- We call this a form!

**2-D:** two dimensional piece, is flat

- We call this a shape!



*Sculpture: a three dimensional piece of art*

*- Can be made out of anything!*



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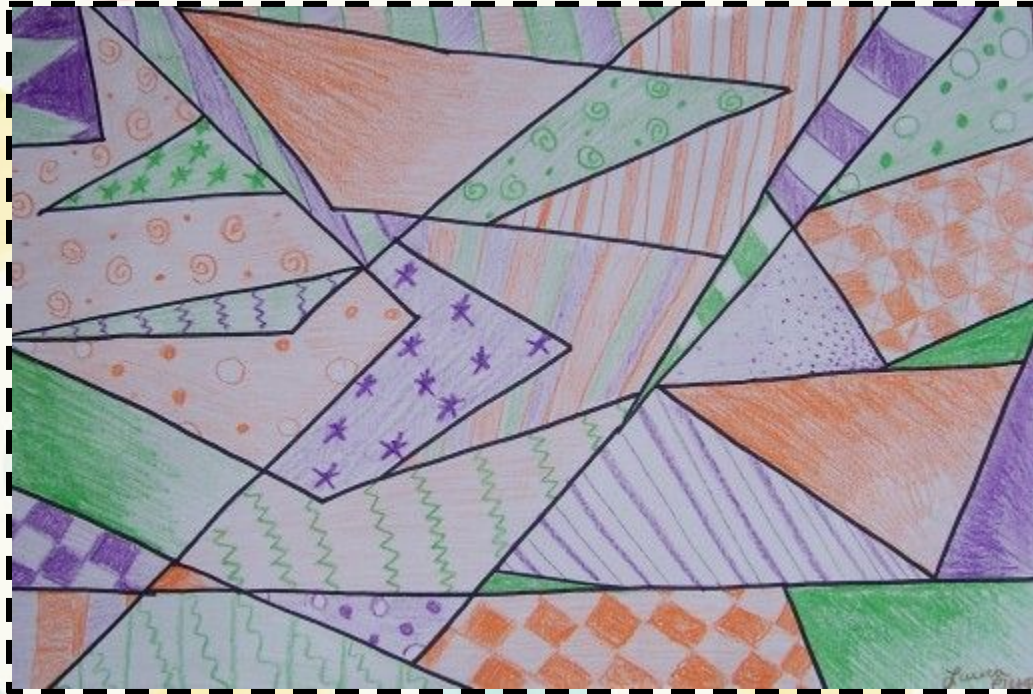
*Space: the way an area is used within and around an art piece*



- *Positive Space*
  - *What is in the foreground?*
  - *This looks closer to you*
- *Negative Space*
  - *What is in the background?*
  - *This looks further away from you*

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*Angles: the way lines intersect, approach, and meet*



*Earthwork: using a mix of nature and materials to create a sculpture/piece of art*



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# *Materials: what is used to make something*

- Think about how ingredients are the materials to cook a meal!*



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*Symbol: when something represents a deeper meaning (ex, a dove is a symbol of peace)*
